

UGA GWINNETT CAMPUS STUDENT FEE POLICY

As of 9/1/08

Prior to Fall semester 2008, students pursuing degree programs at the UGA Gwinnett Campus had the option to either elect to pay the student fee package * assessed for Athens students (comprised of activity, athletic, health, Ramsey Center, and transportation) or waive the package in its entirety. However, in recognition of the unique identity of each UGA campus, student input was captured at each campus for the formation of a student fee package reflective of what the student needs and demands were at their particular campus. At the UGA Gwinnett Campus, the desired fee package consists of a \$45 activity fee (again, the technology fee is standard to all UGA students) to fund – for example – academic and professional development seminars and events, student professional and/or social organizations and gatherings, discounted tickets to Atlanta-area cultural events, on-campus cultural offerings, diversity educational opportunities, wellness informational events, and other Student Affairs activities. This fee package was adopted as of Fall semester, 2008.

Currently, Gwinnett students are assessed as follows:

- Gwinnett students who are **exclusively taking 6 or more hours of a Gwinnett degree program at the Gwinnett Campus**** are assessed the \$45 fee + **technology fee.**
- Gwinnett students **taking 6 or more credit hours at the Athens campus** (whether in conjunction or not with Gwinnett courses) **will have to pay the full Athens fee package** [+ standard technology fee] referenced above for that semester and cannot waive the package.
- Gwinnett students **taking less than 6 hours at Athens** (in conjunction or not with Gwinnett hours) can waive the Athens fee package but still **have to pay the Athens transportation fee** + standard technology fee, for the transportation fee is assessed to Athens students if they are taking one or more credit hours at Athens.

The Office of Extended Campuses is working with both the Registrar and the Bursar to complete the computer programming needed to accurately – and fully – identify all UGA Gwinnett students (those whose degree program is based at the Gwinnett campus) for purposes of student fee assessment, and we ask for your patience as we proceed with the implementation process. * Students taking one or more hours at any UGA campus are assessed the technology fee, and this fee is thus not part of the fee package discussed herein.

** Students who are taking less than 6 hours at Gwinnett (and no other hours elsewhere) must actively opt to waive the \$45 Gwinnett activity fee in OASIS. It is not an automatic waiver.
