- IMPORTANT** Non-UGA students MUST complete the Transfer Student Application found on-line https://www.admissions.uga.edu/apps/off_site. Please note that you will have to create an account (which is free) and that there is a \$60 transient application fee when you are ready to submit the application. Make sure to indicate within the application the study abroad program and the term on which you want to participate and be sure to send a copy of your acceptance letter to UGA to the UGA Costa Rica office. Fax the *Mandatory Certificate of Immunization* form found at www.uhs.uga.edu/documents/immunization-forms-12-08.pdf to the UGA Costa Rica office.
- Submit official transcript. First semester freshmen must submit high school transcript. Second semester freshman please submit your college transcript.
- Request two recommendations or references. (Use attached forms.)
- \$300 deposit will be made payable via the UGA student accounts system the week following submission of this application. No application is complete without the deposit, which will be deducted from the total cost of the program. The deposit will be refunded if the applicant is not accepted, or if the applicant withdraws by the program's withdrawal deadline.
- Turn in the complete application to the UGA Costa Rica Office. (Only complete applications will be considered. A complete application includes the application form, statement of purpose, transcript, & paid deposit on your student account.)

Study Abroad Policies, agreement, release and application signature (Read carefully!)

1. Students' applications WILL be accepted after application deadlines if the program is not yet full.
2. All students (UGA, non-UGA, in-state, and out-of-state) pay in-state tuition. The transient application, \$50 processing fee (checks only), and immunization form are required for non-UGA students to enroll per the Admissions Office. Also, the Bursar's Office charges \$250 for non-UGA students (waived for USG & SEC students).
3. Program fees may change due to unforeseen circumstances. Airfare is an additional expense and students will be responsible for making their own flight reservations.
4. Applications are NOT complete without a deposit which will be applied to your student account one week following the submission of this application; and all other required documents.
5. Deposits will be refunded if the applicant is not accepted or withdraws prior to the withdrawal deadline.
Withdrawal deadline:
Maymester and summer programs – March 19th, 2010
6. Early applicants who receive a special offer and withdraw from a program prior to the withdrawal deadline will receive a pro-rated refund.
7. Applications will be reviewed by program directors and faculty; decisions regarding acceptance will be announced no later than 2 weeks after the application deadline. Acceptance materials will be mailed no later than 2 weeks after the announcements of acceptances.
8. If a student is dismissed from the program while in-country, no refund will be made of any fees paid.
9. Programs are subject to cancellation due to insufficient student enrollment. In this case, a full refund of program fees will be returned to applicants.
10. In the event a program is cancelled due to terrorism, a State Department warning, or other circumstances that could make the program location unsafe, all monies not already spent on behalf of the student will be refunded.
11. I understand that if I withdraw after the withdrawal deadline, for any reason, I will not only forfeit the deposit but must also pay a pro-rated share of the program cost, determined by the Program Director and based on costs incurred by the Program on my behalf.

I hereby acknowledge that I have read, understand and will comply with the above policies. I hereby authorize officials at any university I have attended to release my disciplinary records to the study abroad program director of the program to which I am applying. I fully understand that my disciplinary records may be a factor in evaluating my application.
