

**Instructions for Non-UGA Students
Applying to UGA as a Transient Student (Undergraduates)**

1. Do NOT submit the on-line application!
2. Go to www1.admissions.uga.edu/pdf/transfer_app.pdf
3. Print the pdf version of the application and complete it. Check 'summer transient' for Maymester and Summer programs.
4. Attach a letter of good standing or an official transcript from your home institution.
5. Send the completed application plus the \$50 application fee to your study abroad program director. He or she will forward it to Admissions for you.
6. **Note:** Students who are neither Georgia residents, nor currently enrolled in a University System of Georgia institution will need to pay an additional fee of \$125 to the program.

**Instructions for Non-UGA Students
Applying to UGA as a Transient Student (Graduates)**

1. If you are currently enrolled in a graduate program in the U.S., you can apply to UGA as a transient student.
2. Go to <https://applyweb.com/apply/ugg> to complete the Online Graduate Application. You must establish an account in order to do this. You may want to look at the website's instructions and tips for filling out the online application: <http://www.applyweb.com/instructions?ugg>
3. Be sure to select transient status.
4. It is easiest to pay the \$50 application fee by credit card.
5. Submit a letter of good standing. You do not need to send a copy of your transcript or proof of the highest degree you have received. You do not need to submit GRE scores to be admitted as a transient student.
6. In addition to the Graduate School's requirements (listed above), you will need to submit additional documents requested by the academic department that is sponsoring the program. Contact your program director for further details.
7. If you are not currently enrolled in a graduate program in the U.S. or if you will complete your graduate program before the study abroad program begins, you will need to enroll as a Non-degree seeking student. You will need to apply on-line and select non-degree status. You will also need to submit proof of the highest degree you have earned and provide any documentation provided by the department.
8. **Note:** Students who are neither Georgia residents, nor currently enrolled in a University System of Georgia institution will need to pay an additional fee of \$125 to the program.
