## **M.Ed. & Ed.S. in Elementary Mathematics Education P-5 Early Childhood Mathematics Endorsement Cohort Starting Summer 2010**

**Q: Where and when will the courses be held?**

**A: Courses will be held on the UGA Griffin Campus in the evenings and summers.**

**Q: Will the P-5 Endorsement courses count towards an M.Ed. or an Ed.S.?**

**A: Yes. All five courses count towards an M.Ed. or an Ed.S. in Elementary Mathematics Education. Nine credit hours may be taken as a non-degree seeking student before transferring to the degree program. There are 12 courses in the M.Ed. program and 11 in the Ed.S. program.**

**Q: How long does it take?**

**A: The P-5 Endorsement takes approximately 1 year.  
The M.Ed./Ed.S. takes approximately 2 years.**

**Q: How do I apply?**

**A: See <http://www.uga.edu/griffin> for application information. Click on “Degrees” and scroll down to Mathematics Education. P-5 Endorsement applicants should apply as non-degree seeking students. The online application is at <http://www.grad.uga.edu> (Admissions).**

**Q: How much will it cost?**

**A: The current tuition rate is \$250 per semester hour. Fees are ~\$259/semester. Books are ~\$50/semester. An estimated overall cost for the P-5 Endorsement is \$5,320 and for the degree programs is \$13,000.**

**Q: What financial aid or incentives are available?**

**A: Governor Perdue has promised \$1,000 stipends for teachers who earn the P-5 math endorsement. See <http://www.uga.edu/griffin> for other scholarship opportunities.
