The ***statement of interest*** should share what academic honesty means to you and why you would like to become an Honesty Ambassador with the Student Academic Honesty Council. What interests you about the Student Academic Honesty Council? Why did you decide to seek to volunteer with the Council? In what ways do you think you can make a contribution to the Council and the University? Your ***resume*** should offer a complete summary of your work and academic experience. Be sure to list any knowledge, skills or abilities that you believe would be helpful to you serving as an Honesty Ambassador.
