



Social Gerontology Faculty

The [Department of Sociology and Social Work](#) at University of Central Missouri seeks candidates for one tenure-track Assistant Professor of Social Gerontology position, effective August 2009. The position involves teaching responsibilities in social gerontology and sociology and the coordination of the graduate social gerontology program. Experience working in gerontology settings is desirable, but not required. Coordinating the Social Gerontology program includes responsibilities such as student recruitment and advising and building and maintaining relationships with agencies/organizations serving older adults. The candidate would need to conduct scholarly research and serve on university committees. Preference will be given to candidates who have expertise and research interest in aging and program evaluation and there is the possibility of summer employment.

Minimum requirements include: a PhD in Social Gerontology, Sociology, or a closely-related field; ABD with defined completion date will be considered; evidence of potential for teaching excellence in social gerontology, experience in program evaluation, commitment to program development, and the ability to work in a collegial manner with sociology and social work faculty members, faculty from other disciplines across campus, and professionals in the broader community. The candidate will be expected to teach in various capacities including distance education (online and/or ITV); and will be expected to teach in Warrensburg and Lee's Summit, MO. Candidates invited for an interview will be required to give a research presentation and participate in formal interviews.
