

HOW TO APPLY FOR AN EHS INTERNSHIP

Who Can Apply?

Students applying for Internships (EHSC 3910) must be majors in the Environmental Health Science Program. Students applying for Internships have to meet the following criteria:

- n** have satisfactorily completed at least **6 hours of EHSC courses**, including EHSC 3060. Additional course work may be required by a specific employer.
- n** must be in **good academic standing** (not on probation) and have at least a 2.0 GPA.

How do I Apply?

- n** must submit a **written application** (purple sheet) to the coordinator to enroll in EHSC 3910 at least 10 weeks in advance of entrance.
- n** submit a **resume`** of personal academic and employment background.
- n** must **obtain approval** for internship by the intern coordinator and the student's faculty advisor.
- n** **register for at least 3 hours** of EHSC 3910 **during the semester of internship.**
