Payment and Refund Schedule**

**Fees to be paid to the UGA Bursar's Office**

Tuition and fees should be paid directly to the UGA Bursar's Office after course registration according to regular UGA payment schedule. Payment instructions will be given when you register in OASIS.

- Tuition: \$1026 for 6 credit hours (NOTE: You must register for 6 credit hours).
- Technology Fee: \$21
- For non-University System of Georgia, out-of-state residents: \$250 out-of-state fee

**Fees to be paid to the Program**

- Program Fees: \$3700
- Airfare: \$2000

Make checks payable to: UGA, Maymester in Tanzania

- Application and \$200 non-refundable application fee due by: January 18.
- First installment of \$2200 due by: February 18.
- Second installment \$1090 due by March 3.
- Third installment \$1650 due by March 17.
- Fourth and final installment of \$1650 due by: April 7.

**Deferred payment of program fees:**

You must provide African Studies Institute with a copy of the award letter for any loans, grants, scholarships that you will use to cover any portion of the program fee in order to defer this payment until funds are received. This must be done prior to the deadline stated for payments. You will be required to pay any portion of the program fee not covered by financial aid at the stated deadlines. You may not defer payment of application fee!

**Refund Schedule**

- If the program is full at the time a student applies, or the student is not accepted into the program, the \$200 application fee will be refunded.
- If a student withdraws from program on or before April 14, 2008 then student will receive a refund of all fees minus \$200 application fee and all fees already paid by program on behalf of student.
- If a student withdraws from program after April 14, 2008 no refund will be made to student of any fees paid.

**Program Cancellation**

- If the program is cancelled due to insufficient student enrollment, then a full refund of monies paid will be given to each student.
- If the program is cancelled due to an act of war or terrorism, a State Department warning or other circumstances that make the program location unsafe, all monies not already spent on behalf of the student will be refunded to each student.

**Requests for Refunds**

- All requests for refunds must be made **in writing** to the program director, and received in the African Studies Institute office (321 Holmes/Hunter Academic Bldg, UGA, Athens, GA 30602) by deadlines noted above.
